Aim

13. To provide a conduit to affiliated societies.
14. To maintain a presence on social media.

Membership

There will be 4 committee members composed of the following:

1. Chair
2. Administrator
3. Consultant representative
4. Trainee representative

The Chair will be appointed by nomination for a term of 3 years. Representatives will be appointed by application for 2 year terms. The administrator will be a substantive

appointment made by the Executive committee. The committee will meet 4 times a year: twice face to face, twice by virtual meeting.

In addition, there will be a panel of Content Curators. They will be responsible for submitting information for dissemination to the membership. The curators will represent BAPS and the membership:
