New Curriculum

The way we use ISCP is changing, from August 2021 the new curriculum and assessment system will go live. A new multi-consultant report will be the basis for trainees assessment and progression, it incorporates the Generic Professional Capabilities and Capabilities in Practice. A trial MCR is available from 24th Feb for centres to familiarise themselves with the new format.

All the information is available on ISCP but the basis of the changes are:

- Training will be arranged in phases
- Trainees will be assessed through the MCR
- Generic Professional Capabilities will carry equal weight to CiPs
- Capabilities in Practice will indicate the end-point of training
- Supervision levels indicate when a trainee is ready to complete training
- The learning agreement will focus training on outcomes
- The role of WBAs will be re-balanced
- New transition arrangements will apply

Exams

- Part 1 dates in June and November 2021
 - o Key change that both papers are now single best answer
 - Curriculum for revision available on ISCP, <u>no change</u> from previous as exam follows same syllabus
- Part 2 dates in June and September 2021, March 2021 unfortunately cancelled
 - Key change of <u>no patients</u> and 2 x 15 minute patient stations will be replaced by
 2 x 15 minute clinical scenarios

National Selection

National Selection will be run virtually due to COVID restrictions, this amounts to three 10 minute stations conducted by two interviewers on a virtual platform. The self assessment has undergone validation and adjusted scores may be appealed.
